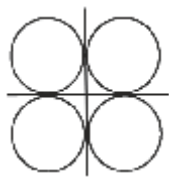

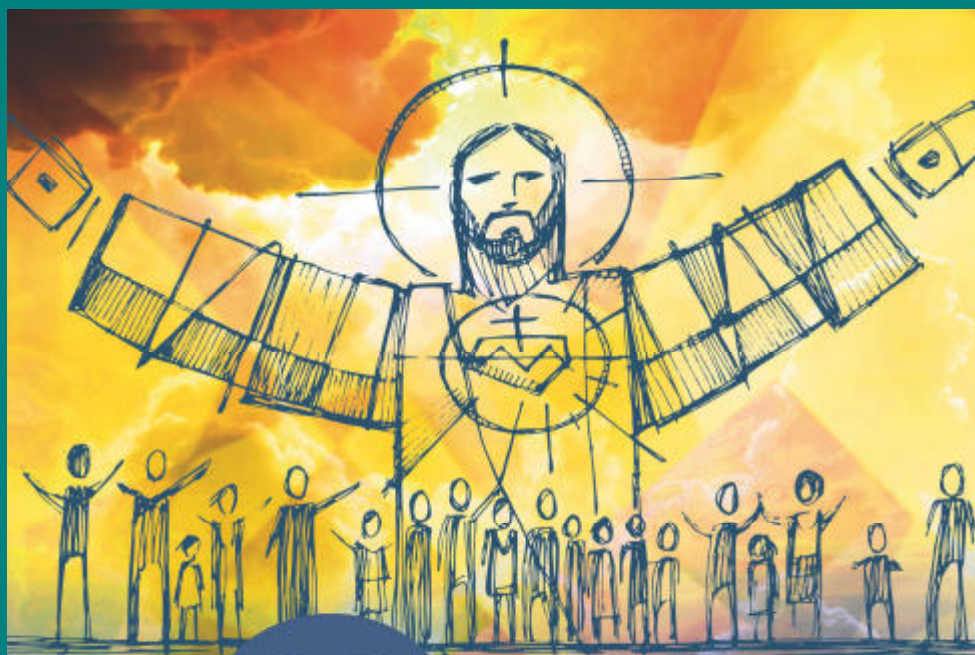

Seeds for the Journey

I am gladly grateful that I have made tremendous progress in my recovery. I'm feeling better day by day even though the healing process is slow. I want to say thank you from the bottom of my heart for your prayers, get well cards, email messages, phone calls and all support. I had some tough days and sleepless nights with discomfort and a lot of pain, but I knew your prayers would bring relief. When I called my mother to inform her about the surgery, she was worried. She asked me, "Who will take care of you because your family members are far away in other States and in Kenya?" I told her not to worry because I have a very good caring staff and parishioners. I'm therefore grateful for all the support I got from our St. Paul's family. I appreciate the help from Dr. Holley my primary care physician, Dr. DiMarco my urologist, Dr. Eichel my surgeon, other staff at RGH and Center for Urology and visiting nurses from Lifetime Care Home Services.

When did my problem start? Or when did I discover I have prostate cancer? Well, it was last year around November I started having some urinary problems. I googled what would be the cause of those symptoms and realized it could be prostate enlargement. I tried to change my diet and buy some supplements and I lost 15-20 pounds. I remember few parishioners mentioning to me that I have lost some weight. After few months on March 1, I decided to write a letter to my doctor to explain my situation: "Dear Dr Holley, This is to draw your attention that I'm having the following urinary symptoms that might be associated with prostate enlargement and I fear it can lead to prostate cancer...I have my usual appointment with you on May 10th. Do I need to wait till then or I should come to see you before? You are my doctor please help me because this problem is devastating and affects my sleep. Thanking you for all your help."

Immediately the doctor received the letter, her office called saying that I should go the following day. She checked me and order PSA test and then sent me to see Dr. DiMarco the urologist. Seeing elevated PSA, he scheduled for Biopsy and the result was one sample out of twelve had tumor with cancer. This followed a lot of tests such as bone scan whole body series, pelvis scan and genetic/DNA. We discussed and agreed the best treatment is surgery and he told me, "I will send you to Dr. Eichel who is one of the best urologist-surgeons." One week after successful surgery I had ultrasound CT Scan Fluoroscopy and several visits to the Center for Urology. My letter to the doctor saved me a lot because it led the cancer to be discovered at an early stage.

I thank God for his healing presence. As Nancy Stout put it in her small booklet, "*Where is God in my Suffering?*" "I have learned about finding God in the midst of suffering, both from my own experience and from stories shared with me" (Page 2). Suffering sickness can be an opportunity for personal growth and a chance to deepen faith and trust in God and community. Sometimes we can lose sight of the love and support that is around us. I am therefore grateful for your love, prayers and support throughout the years I have been here in good times and difficult ones. For your many acts of caring and kindness, I say many thanks.

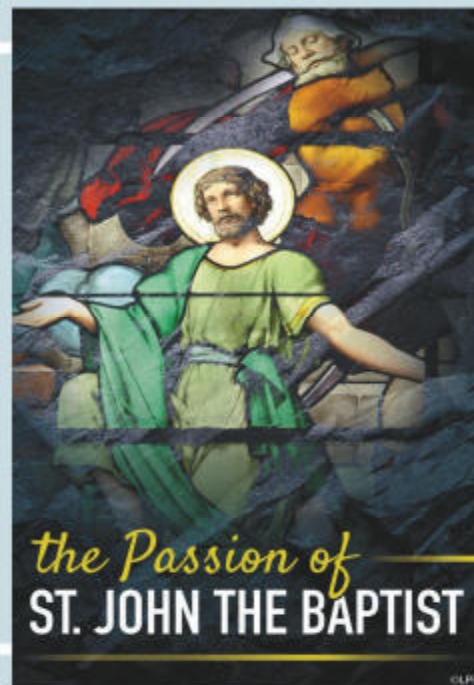
