






stop you from coming, we will show you how. There is no commitment necessary. All are welcome.



Pope Francis announced during today's general audience that Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonized on April 27, 2025 during the Jubilee of Teenagers.

Pope Francis announced at his November 20, 2024, Wednesday General Audience that there will be two noteworthy canonizations of saints during the upcoming Jubilee Year which begins December 24, 2024, and ends on December 23, 2025. One of these saints is Blessed Carlos Acutis who died of Leukemia at age 15 in 2006. Blessed Acutis used his computer skills to help spread the Catholic faith. He will be canonized on April 27, 2025, during the Jubilee celebrations for teenagers/adolescents in Rome.


