



Seeds for the Journey

The Bible has many verses about LOVE...

How to Love Others:

- John 15:12: "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you".
- Luke 6:3: "Do to others as you would have them do to you".
- 1 Corinthians 16:14: "Do everything in love".
- 1 Peter 4:8: "Above all hold unfailing your love for one another, since love covers a multitude of sins".

How God Loves Us:

- John 3:16: "For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life".
- 1 John 4:19: "We love because he first loved us".

How Love is a Virtue:

- 1 Corinthians 13:4–8a: "Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude".
- Colossians 3:14-17: "Love combines every virtue together to form a perfect unity".
- Ephesians 5:25: "For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her".

There are different types of LOVE....

Agape: A selfless, universal love that is unconditional and can be applied to anyone or anything. It's a type of everlasting love where you care for someone without expecting anything in return.

<u>Philia:</u> A love between equals that's often considered safe and beneficial. It's a love that's based on shared experiences.

<u>Pragma:</u> A practical, enduring type of love that's focused on compatibility and has moved beyond the initial physical needs of a relationship.

<u>Eros:</u> A romantic love that's often experienced as a fairytale-type love. It's characterized by intense attraction and an urgent desire to deepen the relationship.

<u>Ludus:</u> A playful love that's characterized by flirtation, seduction, and sex without commitment. It's often evident at the beginning of a relationship.

<u>Philautia:</u> A healthy form of self-love that involves recognizing your self-worth and taking care of your personal needs.

<u>Obsessive love:</u> A type of love that's more about control than love. It's often characterized by one person in a relationship wanting to control or possess the other.

Storge: A type of family love.

There are 5 different LOVE Languages...

Words of affirmation: Saying kind and complimentary things to someone.

Quality time: Spending focused, uninterrupted time together.

Physical touch: Expressing affection through physical contact like hugs, kisses, and hand holding.

Acts of service: Doing helpful tasks for someone.

Receiving gifts: Giving thoughtful presents to show love.



Gately, Edwina In God's womb

Edwina Gately founded Voluntary Missionary Movement in her native Britain and in Genesis House in Chicago. In this memoir, written in both prose and poetry, she tries to answer the question about why she is still a member of the Roman Catholic Church in spite of the fear of some bishops that somehow she is a threat to the faith. She attributes her motivation and passion, not to reading books and studying theology, but to her experience of God in her own life. She believes life's journey is the call to love one another, no matter what. To keep stumbling faithfully toward God, no matter how dark things become. Genesis House gives an excellent example. For many years, this was a safe place for women recovering from prostitution, but a new leadership team sabotaged its mission, even exiling Gately, its founder, from the premises, But God remained with her, even in this dark moment. 
