



# Seeds for the Journey

#### The Nunc Dimittis

On February 2 each year, our Holy mother, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This occurs exactly forty days after Christmas. Following the law of Moses, Joseph and Mary took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, where he was consecrated, and his parents offered a sacrifice of a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons. Overtime, the practice developed where Christians bring candles to be blessed at this Mass.

Today's feast invites us to reflect on how we prepare ourselves to receive Jesus Christ in our participation at the Eucharist. The Holy Family made their preparations and purifications before entering the temple to present the Lord. How can we prepare and purify ourselves so that we can receive the Lord in our own temples? What are those areas in our lives where tarnish has built up: the tarnish of pride, selfishness, unkind acts, broken relationships, prejudice, injustice?

Today's feast also invites us to reflect on the ever presence of Christ who brings light to the world. Christ who frees us from the darkness of sin. Present in the Temple during the Presentation were the righteous man Simeon and the prophetess Anna. Both Simeon and Anna were advanced in age and were awaiting the birth of the messiah who will bring about the redemption of Jerusalem.

During the Presentation, Simeon said the following prayer, which we now refer to in Latin as the *Nunc Dimittis*. This prayer is recited at night by priests, deacons, religious, seminarians and all those who pray the Compline. I also invite you to recite this prayer before going to bed:

### The *Nunc Dimittis* Prayer

Save us Lord while we are awake. Protect us while we sleep. That we may keep watch with Christ and rest with him in peace.

Lord, Let your servant go in peace, according to your promise. For my eyes, have seen your salvation, which you have prepared for all the world to see. The Light of revelation for the Gentiles and the Glory of your people Israel.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning is now, and ever shall be, world without end Amen.

Save us Lord while we are awake. Protect us while we sleep. That we may keep watch with Christ and rest with him in peace.

## St. Paul's Memorials

Did you know that St. Paul's offers a few different ways to honor/remember your loved ones?

<u>Votive Candles</u>: As you say a prayer to our Mother Mary, you may light one of our votive candles that twinkle in the corner of the worship area. Candles can be lit at any time. Once a candle is lit it will automatically stay luminated for five days. Envelopes for your free will donation are located on the tower shelf close to the kneeler.

<u>Sanctuary Lamp</u>: Our sanctuary lamp in the worship area can be booked in honor/memory of your loved one a week at a time. The lamp is currently being booked for 2025 and there are quite a few weeks available. The donation for the lamp is \$15 and the name of your loved one is published in the bulletin.

Sanctuary Flowers: We are currently booking Sanctuary Flowers for 2025. Flowers are on display in the sanctuary on any available weekend of your choice. The minimum donation for flowers is \$50. Your loved ones name will also be published in the bulletin.

<u>Memorial Donations:</u> You may make a Memorial Donation in honor/memory of someone at any time throughout the year. If you would like an acknowledgment to be sent please include the name and address of the next kin.



## Green, S.J., Thomas H. Experiencing God

Father Green reminds us that prayer is, above all, a relationship with God and the deepening of our experience with God. As a spiritual director, Father Green spent years teaching fellow Christians to pray. This slim volume is drawn from his lectures; it is a treasury of his best insights, now in print for the first time. He discusses the three stages of growth: knowing God; experiencing God; and finally, being transformed by God. Sometimes growth is painful. Although God loves our growth, some people are threatened by it. But once we begin to value being loving, more than being holy, we can say we've begun the experience of a real relationship-- one of giving God Joy rather than getting something for ourselves. 
