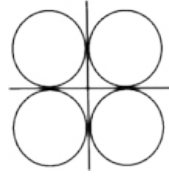


Mission Cooperation Plan 2024 Second Collection

Every year St. Paul's joins in the Mission Church and welcomes a visiting missionary to tell their story and experiences through the Missionary Cooperation Plan. Next weekend, June 22 & 23 we welcome Fr. Jerry Aman, SJ, from the Jesuits-USA NE Province.

Fr. Jerry is originally an upstate New York (Penfield) farm boy who joined the Jesuits after attending McQuaid Jesuit High School. After ordination in 1973 he served as Chaplain at Canisius High School in Buffalo for ten years. Then he was missioned to St. Joseph's Church in Benin city, Nigeria. He has spent close to 40 years in various ministries in Africa, including building the first Jesuit Secondary School in Nigeria, Loyal Jesuit college, and last year celebrated his 50th year of priestly ordination.

Our donations will support the Jesuits Mission in the North West African Province of the Society of Jesus in four West African countries: Nigeria, Ghana, Sierra Leone and Liberia. The Jesuits run several parishes, five secondary schools, four primary schools, three retreat centers, a social justice center and they also have the Jesuit Refugee Services program that proves assistance to refugees.

Recognize God in Your Ordinary Moments St. Anthony Can Find Anything — Even You

“Tony, Tony, come around! Something is lost and it must be found.”

Did you learn this one when you were a kid? In my experience there are even a lot of lapsed Catholics — or people who were never Catholic at all — who know that when you lose something, St. Anthony becomes your best friend. Missing keys? Pray to St. Anthony. Can't find your favorite sweater? St. Anthony. Forget where you parked your car in the mall lot? St. Anth— okay, you get the idea. Whatever it is, large or small, important or trivial, Tony has a reputation for finding the lost things.

It's a devotion that can seem a little like superstition — witchcraft, even? — if you don't really understand it. Mumble an incantation to a dead guy and you're guaranteed to find your sunglasses. But as with most traditions that are old, beloved and effective, looking a little closer reveals the truth of the matter.

When we lose something really important, what do we do? We make the whole household stop what they're doing to join the search. Having St. Anthony as a friend means you ask him to stop what he's doing to help, too. And how he helps is by taking the matter exactly where all matters need to go — straight to the feet of Christ.

Here's the real genius of St Anthony: he takes the most mundane, commonplace occurrence — misplacing socks — into an encounter with the divine and truly all things great and small are gifts from God. He grabs our hand and points to the cross. “That's what you're looking for,” he tells us.

In the end, Tony doesn't really find the lost things. He finds the lost people.

No Problem

(Turning the Next Corner in Your Spiritual Life)

Robert Wicks considers this book an inner workshop for the soul which will guide its readers to personal transformation through twenty lessons, three doorways, and thirty daily exercises. He wants us to live (not just say) a simple prayer and to look outward as well as inward. The chapters are quite brief, and he suggests that we read one chapter and seek to take to heart its story and the point it makes over the following twenty-four hours. We can reflect on it for a few seconds even as we go about our daily activities or just before we fall asleep. In our busy day, we need to give ourselves time to breathe and reflect. 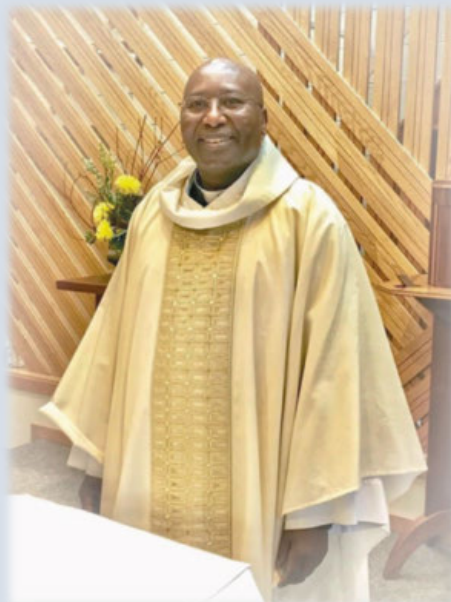

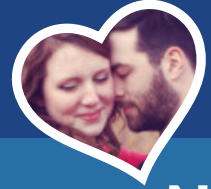
