





Seeds for the Journey

November is the month when we Catholics prayerfully remember those who've gone before us. We celebrate All Saints' Day and All Souls Day "to remind us that death is not the end, but rather the door through which we must pass to gain eternal life." (U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops)

St. Paul's Parish is blest with ministries that provide support, guidance and comfort to those experiencing or anticipating the death of a loved one. Recently, I have taken on the role of Funeral Planner. I am proud and impressed by the dedication and compassion of those who volunteer and participate in these important ministries. Let me tell you a bit more about them.

First, if you have a desire to help...

The **Funeral Ministry Team** is a group of persons who assist in various ways with funerals at St. Paul's. The warmth, guidance and gentle manners of these people provide a welcoming face when families are grieving. The many thank-you notes that arrive following the funerals attest to the beautiful success of this ministry.

Funerals are held on weekdays or Saturday mornings usually at 10am. Volunteers are contacted a few days prior to a funeral with information about duties that need to be filled, such as, Greeters, Ushers, and especially Acolytes. Volunteers arrive about 30 minutes prior to the funeral Mass and remain until a few minutes after the liturgy. If you are already an Usher, Greeter or Acolyte please consider this spiritually rewarding way to serve fellow parishioners during a difficult time.

Second, if you are grieving the loss of a loved one...

Together in Grief, is a bereavement program that offers support and friendship to people grieving the death of a loved one. Those who attend the monthly gatherings accompany one another through listening, sharing stories, enjoying refreshments and praying together. Each member pledges confidentiality and respect. **Meetings are held on the third Thursday each month at 11:00am - 12:30pm from September through June.**

Third, if you would like to pre-plan your funeral ...

Advance Funeral Planning is a simple act that allows a person to plan a funeral prior to death. The information on our parish website along with the guidance of the funeral planner, allows you to choose scriptural readings and hymns, and lets your family know your wishes for your funeral liturgy. This will give peace of mind to you and your family since there will be less difficult decisions to make at a time of emotional hardship.

"When I walk into the church with the chairs arranged in a semicircle facing the altar, it feels like I am a part of a huge hug." (Words spoken by a person planning the funeral of a loved one here at St. Paul's.) Those words touched my heart and reminded me of the compassion and generous spirit of our parish. You, with your smile and welcoming heart, are the face of Christ for others.

This is the annual opportunity for the Diocesan Directors of the Propagation of the Faith and Mission Office to come together to work and plan for the upcoming year.


Thank you for your understating and prayers. I will pray for all your intentions during Mass while I am away.

All are welcome to join us on Thursday, December 5 at 6:30 p.m. in the worship area. Our guest speaker, Fr. John Mack has a Masters degree in theology and a Licentiate of Sacred Theology (STL). He currently serves as the priest Chaplain of the Aquinas Institute. He has been ordained nearly 40 years for the Diocese of Buffalo. Retired from active ministry, he resides in his family home in Rochester, working part-time at Aquinas and occasionally helping at the Catholic Newman Community, University of Rochester. The past 15 years of ministry, Fr. Mack has participated in the initial priestly formation program for seminarians at Christ the King Seminary, East Aurora and Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology, Hales Corners, WI. He has taught in two Catholic High Schools and has twice served as a pastor in diocesan parishes. Fr. Mack is a liver transplant recipient (30 June 2020) from a living donor (former parishioner) and is a volunteer for the Friends of Strong Liver and Kidney Transplant patient visitors.






Together in Grief



Nouwen, Henri Ukraine Diary

In this diary, Henri Nouwen reflected on his travels to Ukraine many years previously. When we read it today, this previously unpublished work continues to have special meaning. Several weeks ago Deacon Mark commented on the importance of this journal. He noted that the book "sheds light on the struggles, the hopes, and the dreams of the Ukrainian people in the years immediately following their freedom from Soviet domination." He quoted Nouwen's observation that Ukraine had suffered "from centuries of oppression and exploitation, from neglect and indifference from wealthy nations, from the social sins of injustice and greed." The Ukranian people once again find themselves suffering brutality as they attempt to maintain their sovereignty from Russian violence and cruelty. In the Afterward, Laurent Nouwen, Henri's brother, noted sadly that on February 24, 2022 "all hell broke loose in Ukraine. And the battle rages relentlessly on." (Call No. 282.092-NOU)


Doctrinal Corner
