
Thank you to everyone who has participated in the Parish Census!

Valente, Judith Atchison Blue



The title refers to the special color of the windows of the chapel of Mount St Scholastica Monastery in Atchison, Kansas. Poet and reporter Judith Valenti creates a portrait of the Benedictine sisters who live there. She spent many weeks living with the sisters, trying to under-

stand the Benedictine life. Her visits to the monastery coincided with a pivotal time for her, both personally and professionally. She was struggling with her blended family, with her increasing sense of disconnection from her church, with balancing career demands with spiritual needs. What she lacked in her own life were moments of stillness where she could simply listen and be. She observed the sisters' habits of living mindfully. They infused ordinary acts, such as waking, gardening, and even eating, with meaning. At the Mount, she and her husband encountered the vital, compassionate church of the Gospels, not a tired, passionless, scandal-ridden bureaucracy. (Call No. 271.1-VAL)

Doctrinal Corner

In the Apostles' Creed we pray: 'I believe in the communion of saints.' There is a lot to think about in this short statement. The word communion means a sharing and also communication. Noth meaning s are part of the Communion of Saints, we share our faith with the saints; we share the sacraments with them. We also share our gifts, prayers and charity with them. When we share our faith and communicate with each other, we are part of the Communion of Saints. But how do we communicate with the saints who have already died? In our prayers, we can ask the saints to intercede to God for us. They can hear our prayers and see our needs. The queen of all saints is Mary, the Mother of God. The Church has many prayers and devotions to Mary. We do not adore Mary and the saints. We honor Mary and the saints because of their holy lives, We ask them to pray to God for us and with us. We never pray to them instead of God! Our communion with them lets us join them in adoring and praising God.
