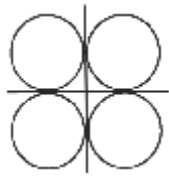

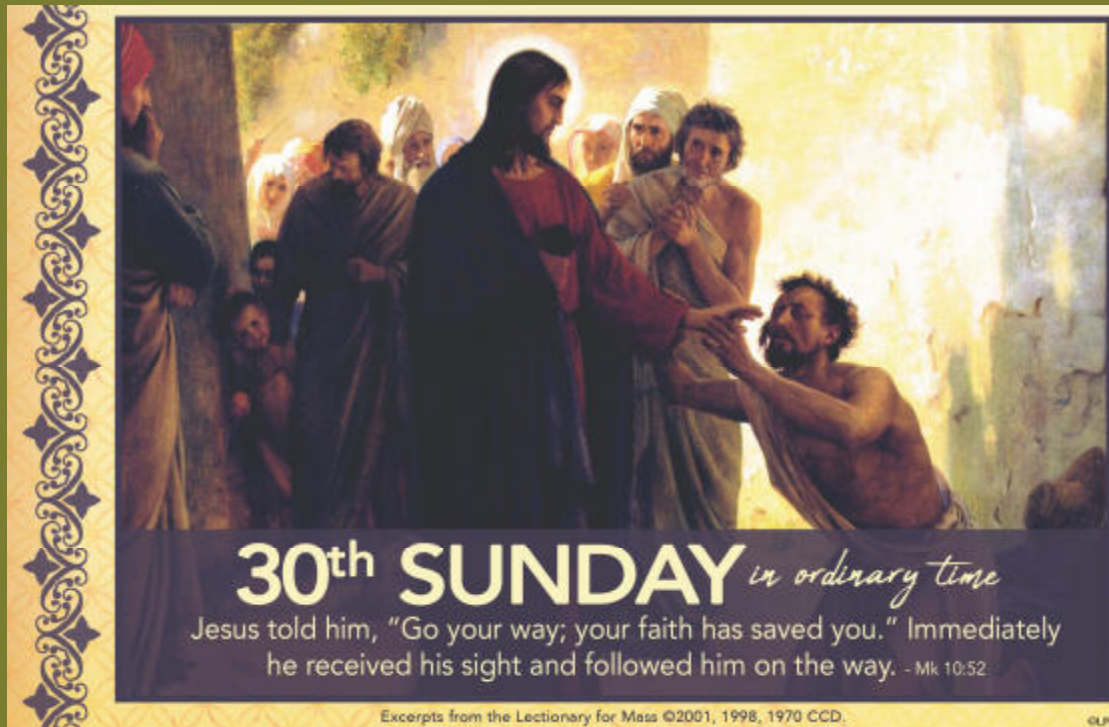

# *Seeds for the Journey*

## **"Kindness Costs You Nothing"**

A couple of Sundays ago, I went to Hegedorns to pick up a few essentials and some subs to enjoy while watching the Bills on TV. I was in a hurry as it was close to game time so I went up to the deli counter thinking that I could put my order in for the subs and then quickly venture my way through the store to do my shopping. When I approached the counter, the young man didn't take my order; he wanted me to stay and wait for my subs while he made them. I must admit I was a bit impatient at first thinking to myself "ugh I'm never going to get out of here." As I stood there, he struck up a conversation with me, no major discussion, just your typical small talk. After a few moments, I thought to myself, this is what I should be doing, I should enjoy the fact that I am actually out of the house interacting with someone in person (with my mask on of course).

Toward the end of our conversation, I happened to look up on the wall and there was a sign that said, "Kindness Costs You Nothing!" I asked him about the sign, and he explained how "rude, mean and impatient" some people can be with those who work there. As I was walking away the young man said, "it was fun talking to you and thanks for being nice to me."

Through this 5-minute conversation with a complete stranger I realized how important it is to think of someone else. Maybe the young man just needed someone to talk to. We need to do more things for one another and not be so centered on ourselves. It's so important to think before we act or speak especially when we know that something we are about to say is unkind. You never know what the person on the other end of your words has going on in their life and how that can negatively impact them.

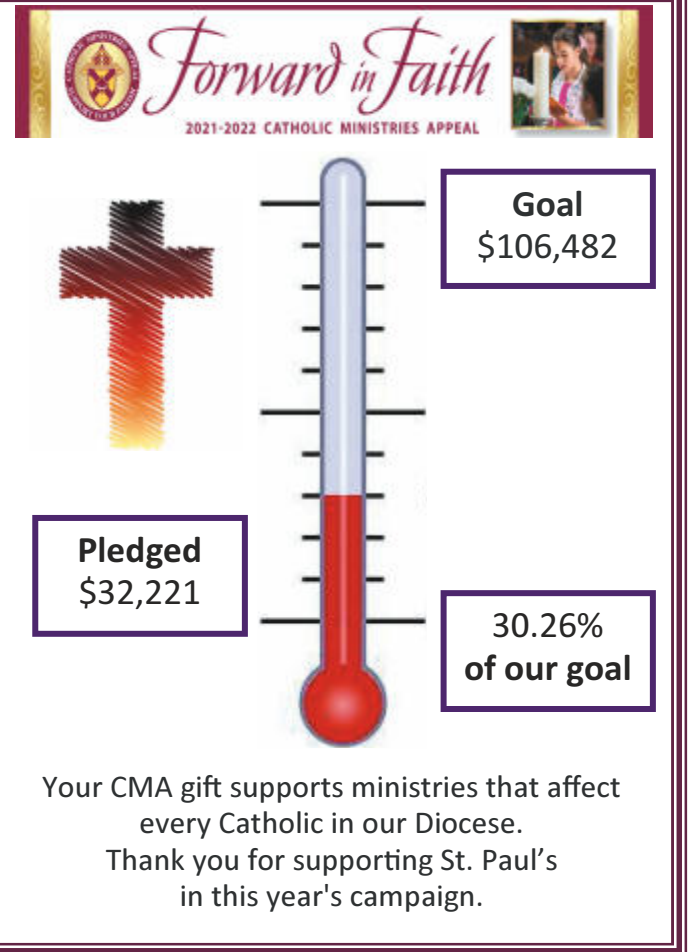

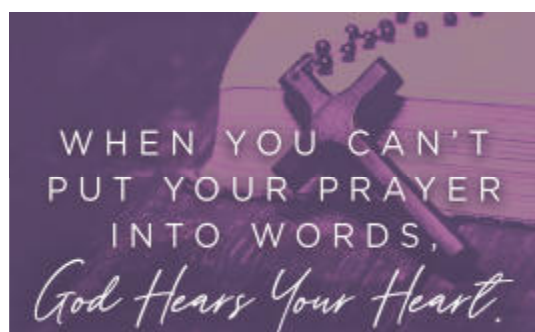

### Recognize God in Your Ordinary Moments "Breaking the Stewardship Mold"

Have you noticed how we always tend to pigeonhole one another — and ourselves? "I could never serve on the Parish Council. That's for Rick and Ellen and that whole group of people who have done it for years." "Greg takes care of faith formation in the parish — he always has. He doesn't need my help." "I can't afford to give the big bucks like those families who sit up front can. My offering wouldn't matter even if I did increase it."

Thinking like this is a good indication that we aren't in conversation with God about what His will is for our lives. If we have already decided what we are and are not meant to do, we aren't likely to pray over it, to discern it.

We have to be open to the spirit of the Lord wherever it leads us, regardless of what we or others have come to expect from us. We human beings come to believe that we are such good judges of what others can offer — or what we ourselves can offer. But God has plans for us to which we aren't privy. God calls everyone to serve Him in the way that pleases Him best, and only He can decide what that is. Everyday Stewardship demands a continual accounting of who we can be, what we can offer — even if it's outside our comfort zone, even if it's something that never occurred to us before.

There's only one Person who can tell us what God wants from us. Do we even think to ask Him?
