Meeting opened at 7PM with opening prayer and the agenda was approved by unanimous vote. Prior meeting minutes were not available and left open for approval later.

Robin told us that the roof repair was complete and the inside work was in progress to repair ceiling damage and paint.

Transparency Effort

Robin/ Jodie have and will continue to post PPC Agenda and Minutes on the website. We discussed the need to make sure we leave an open invitation for parishioners to passively attend PPC, and they should contact the office to ask for time on the agenda for specific topics to address.

We will continue to invite reps from the various ministries to come share their activities and needs with PPC.

Joe F suggested that we should publish PPC mission and Marianne F recommended a PPC suggestion basket near the PPC photo board in the hall.

Old/New Business

Robin indicated the CDC/DOR guidelines don't allow us to meet in person yet. Not enough space or proper ventilation in the hall for PPC to meet with distancing requirements.

8am Sun Mass was added by Fr Paul for Holy Week capacity. Need to decide if that will continue or if we go back to 9 and 11am again. Next agenda we should address mass schedule going forward.

Deacon Mark spoke about his summary of a recent presentation he attended dealing with the grieving process and needs of the Parish as we try to get COVID 19 behind us. Questions about the “new normal” were addressed and all agreed it was a topic that deserves more time and discussion. Scott R to schedule a PPC Exec meeting to discuss how and when to address this concern.
