As you return to St. Paul's, you will notice many changes have been made. We are doing our best to follow Health Department and CDC guidelines for everyone's safety. If you are feeling ill, please stay home!

Some (updated) things to note as we return to Mass:

- * Each mass attendance is limited to 25% capacity while maintaining social distancing.
- * Bishop Matano has extended his dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass until further notice.
- * Sunday 10:00 Mass will continue to be livestreamed for those who cannot attend.
- * Masks are required to be worn throughout the Mass (ages 2 and older).
- * Please maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- * Please arrive for Mass early to facilitate seating. Enter and exit through the Narthex doors.
- * At this time, we will not be using the exterior doors facing Hard Road to better handle the flow into and out of the building as well as avoiding touching more surfaces. (The doors are available to be used in the event of an emergency.)
- * No physical contact for greetings, the Sign of Peace, and The Our Father prayer.
- * The Gather hymnals have been removed.
- * Please sanitize your hands when you enter the building and after touching any common surfaces.
- * The Baptismal Font and Holy Water have been removed.
- * Bulletins are distributed at the end of mass only to eliminate reuse.
- * Singing by the congregation is discouraged at this time, due to increased respiratory output.
- * Ushers will be assisting with seating and dismissal. Please do not move chairs. After Mass please remain seated and await instruction. Ushers will dismiss based on section (A, B, C, D) and row (back to front).
- * Offertory envelopes may be dropped in the collection boxes or the "Donations" slot. The collection basket will not be passed during Mass. You are also welcome to donate online.
- * The Book of Prayer Intentions has been removed. Please call the office to add either the name of the sick or deceased to the Universal Prayers during Mass.



Holy Communion:



- * The Most Precious Blood will not be distributed at this time.
- * The Most Precious Body will only be distributed to the hand.
- * Holy Communion cannot be distributed or received with gloved hands.
- * Ushers will direct those coming forward for Communion based on sections (A, B, C, D) and row (front to back).

Other considerations:

- * Please use the rest rooms outside the Music Room (by the water fountain.)
- * All rooms downstairs and the Library are closed at this time.
